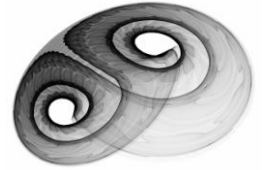

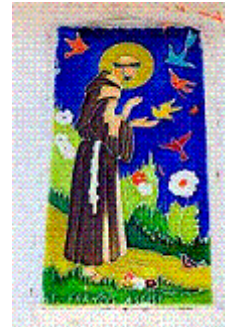
**Seeing through paradox; believing through difference**

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**Henri Bortoft** is an independent researcher in the philosophy of science. He did postgraduate research on the problem of wholeness in quantum physics with David Bohm and Basil Hiley at Birkbeck College. He regularly opens up a new world to his listeners, including on the MSc in Holistic Science at Schumacher College.

**Ilan Pappé** of the Institute of Arab and Islamic studies is one of the world's leading historians of the Middle East, with a distinctive view of Arab-Israeli relations.
